You will then present your results in the form of a poster, something scientists use to let people easily and quickly see their experiments and results.

We hope to invite all entrants to a celebration where they can display their posters for our researchers. The overall winner or winning team will also receive a personal prize.

## What is the competition?

You will be trying to find out more about how enzymes work, by analysing patterns you discover in an experiment.
